If the name of a person or organization is used in your argument/statement as supporting or endorsing the argument/statement, **YOU MUST EITHER:**

1. Use the name of the person or organization with a quotation made by the person on behalf of the person or by an authorized person on behalf of an organization. The quotation must have been disseminated to the public prior to its inclusion in the argument/statement and it must be identified in the argument/statement by its source and date (such as the name of the newspaper in which it appeared) and the date of dissemination/publication. Examples for identifying the source of a quote are:

James Joyce, *The Oregonian*, 1/22/90

### **EXAMPLES:**

Bob Dole, *Time Magazine*, July 7, 1997

John F. Kennedy, *Profiles in Courage*, 1960

### **OR**

2. File a Statement of Endorsement (DC400) signed by the person, or by an authorized person on behalf of an organization, stating that the person consents to the use of the name of the person or organization in the argument/statement. The name of the endorser, including any title or organization must appear in the Douglas County Voters' Pamphlet argument/statement exactly as indicated by the endorser on the DC400.

This Statement of Endorsement (DC400) should be filed with the argument/statement it relates to and must be filed no later than 5:00 pm on the deadline for filing Douglas County Voters' Pamphlet information.

NOTE: If a Statement of Endorsement is not received, the person or organization whose name is mentioned will be edited from the statement or argument. If the information contained in the endorsement designation box on page one of this form (DC400) does not match what is printed in the argument/statement, the argument/statement will be edited to match the Statement of Endorsement form.
