BONDS TO UPGRADE AND EXPAND SCHOOL FACILITIES, IMPROVE SAFETY

**Question** 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall Oakland School District issue \$16,000,000 in bonds to upgrade and expand facilities and potentially receive a \$4,000,000 state grant? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Summary** 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

The District is on the waiting list to receive up to a \$4,000,000 state grant provided that these bonds are approved. If this measure is approved, bonds and grant funds are expected to fund:

- Building a new high school with a modernized career vocational technical facility
- Additional classroom space to relieve overcrowding
- Only if awarded state grant dollars, space would be constructed for student performing arts, athletics, and offices.
- Site improvements, demolition, furnishing and equipment and fees associated with bond issuance costs.

The District would establish a citizen oversight committee to ensure bond proceeds are used for purposes indicated.

Bonds would mature in not to exceed 30 years from issuance. The bonds are estimated to increase the tax rate by \$1.85 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Actual levy rate may differ due to changes in interest rates and/or assessed value.
