Douglas County Transportation District**

(Roseburg, Ore.) Notice is hereby given that the Douglas County Board of Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, August 15, 2018, during the regularly scheduled Board of Commissioners Business Meeting, concerning the matter of the formation of a county-wide transit district.

The meeting will begin at 9:00 am in Room 216 of the Douglas County Courthouse located at 1036 SE Douglas Avenue, Roseburg, Oregon 97470.

The County is proposing the formation of a non-taxing transit district to provide a transportation dedicated entity to manage public transportation funding and public transportation enhancement decisions. The name of the district shall be the Douglas County Transportation District with the boundaries generally coterminous with the boundaries of Douglas County. All interested persons may appear and be heard.
