**For the All Hazards Emergency Response Plan
Regional Trainings**

Who Should Participate:

Local Community Mental Health Program (CMHP) Directors and their disaster preparedness coordinators and staff, local addiction services staff, local public health emergency preparedness coordinators, local emergency managers, local representatives of agencies and organizations that provide behavioral health services during disaster, such as fire department Chaplains, Red Cross Disaster Mental Health, and Department of Justice (DOJ) Victims Assistance/NOVA, local non-CMHP behavioral health professionals, HPP Regional Coordinators, hospitals.

Scope:

This training is to introduce the current Oregon Behavioral Health Emergency Response Plan and Field Guide, and provide an opportunity for CMHPs and local partners to test their ability to implement them within the context of their local behavioral health plans.

Goals:

- Introduce and explain the structure of the Behavioral Health Emergency Response Field Guide and its relationship to Attachment 'F' of the Behavioral Health of the Public Health Base Plan.
- Provide an overview of the basic concepts of behavioral health emergency response.
- Provide opportunity to build local teams and test local behavioral health planning, including roles and responsibilities and lines of communication.

Objectives:

- Participants will acquire sufficient familiarity with the Behavioral Health Emergency Response Field Guide to be able to successfully access needed information during preparedness and response.
- Participants will be able to identify key components of behavioral health emergency response.
- **CMHP participants and their local team of disaster partners** will be able to identify relevant individual roles and responsibilities and lines of communications when implementing their local behavioral health plans.
