Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) Training Course

The three day HSEEP Training Course is an intermediate-level exercise design course developed by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security with input from federal partners, subject matter experts, and state/local representatives. Oregon Public Health is offering this course at **no cost** to participants. The training is interactive and allows participants to share personal lessons learned and best practices while gaining practical experience. The course includes instructor-led presentations, small group activities, videos, and group discussions.

Participants will learn how to use the online HSEEP Toolkit including the Design and Development System that allows for easy creation of a Master Scenario Events List (MSEL) and Exercise Evaluation Guides (EEG). Our course will focus on capabilities based planning and participants **will receive a hard copy of the Target Capabilities List to keep!**

Who Should Attend?

Professionals in emergency preparedness and response fields who would like to have a deeper understanding of exercise design and the HSEEP process.

Since this is an intermediate-level exercise design course, students are required to take the prerequisite course, **IS-120A, *An Introduction to Exercises*** (less than 3 hours to complete) You can find this course at the DHS Learning Center, **Course # C00191**
