# Incident Command System Position Specific Workshops

Oregon Public Health is offering these intermediate-level ICS workshops at **no-cost** to provide Incident Command System (ICS) training to develop additional skills on the roles and functions of specific ICS positions and sections. Each course is roughly seven hours and offered at five locations across the state.

## Who Should Attend?

Anyone who will serve in a specific ICS position or section in an AOC, EOC or ECC, as well as those who are just interested in acquiring a more detailed understanding of these positions and sections. ***These workshops are not a substitute for the 40 hour NIMS compliant ICS position specific courses.***

Since these are intermediate-level workshops, students are required to take the prerequisite courses IS-100 and 200 (less than 3 hours to complete each). You can find these courses at the DHS Learning Center, **Course # C00065, and # C00066**
