UPCOMING FLU VACCINATION CLINICS OPEN TO ALL

The State of Oregon and Douglas County Public Health are partnering with Community Immunization Provider *GetAFluShot.com* to hold clinics to provide H1N1 vaccinations.

Because Oregon's vaccine supply is steadily increasing, State health officials have opened up vaccinations to all who want them, beginning December 14. "Health care providers have been focusing efforts on the highest-risk people, such as pregnant women and people with underlying health conditions," said Dawnelle Marshall, RN, BSN, Douglas County Public Health Division Director. "Oregon's vaccine supply is large enough now that we're able to expand the vaccination program to everyone, but we continue to urge those in the initial risk groups to be vaccinated," said Marshall.

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There is no charge to receive the H1N1 vaccination at these clinics. Persons with health insurance should bring their insurance ID cards or proof of coverage to assist in the completion of forms.

- No co-payments will be collected from anyone with insurance.
- Various insurance will be accepted to cover the administration of the H1N1 vaccine, including: Medicare Part B, Medicaid, Regence BlueCross BlueShield, Cigna, Group Health Cooperative, Care Oregon, Clear Choice, ODS, Uniform Medical Plan of Washington and Aetna.
- No one will be denied an H1N1 vaccination due to lack of coverage.
