**DOG BITE INCIDENT**

The Douglas County Environmental Health Division requests assistance in locating a dog involved in a biting incident.

The bite occurred on Wednesday, January 6, 2010 at the Recycle Center on Thompson Street in Winston, Oregon. An employee at the Center was bitten on his hand by one of two small black and white pug or boxer breed dogs as he reached into the cab of a newer, white Toyota Tacoma extra cab pickup. The dog's owner appeared to be an older male adult – about 6 feet tall, thinly built and possibly wearing glasses. No other information is available at this time.

The dogs need to be found for observation purposes only, as required by law. Anyone with information about the dogs, or their owner, should contact Douglas County Environmental Health Division at 440-3569, or Douglas County Animal Control at 440-4471.
