### Approval of Minutes

3. General discussion on Ice Age Exhibit and Railcar progress. Mural has been installed, specimens will be here the first part of December, hopefully installed and open to public by mid January. The Foundation purchased seven seats for the railcar project, we were able to get all seven seats for \$500.00. They will need to be restored. This led to a general discussion of the rich railroad history of Roseburg and Douglas County.
4. Discussion regarding installation of electric car charging station at the Museum. Commissioner Goodwin will check with other Commissioners on the feasibility of this idea.
5. Freeway signage discussion. Donation of \$8000.00 to Foundation for new freeway sign. Dale suggested a larger sign due to the fact that the sign is on private property, this is not an option as the State regulates the size of signs.

1. Dale will send out an email regarding what day and time works best for all Advisory Meeting members
2. Planning for Anniversary of the Museum & the Roseburg Blast. What would be a good program to celebrate and what is good time in August to do an event. More discussion and planning will be needed. No conclusion was reached

4. Get Museum and events on Community calendar, do a reciprocal admission plan with other Museum's in the State.
5. Sell Corporate passes to Senior Centers etc.
