### OTHER THINGS TO KNOW

- Each CABIN sleeps four.
- Check in time is 2:30 pm/Check out time is 1:30.
- No other camping will be allowed in the CABIN area.
- Parking space is limited to 2 vehicles in the CABIN area; additional parking is available nearby.
- Camper stay limits – May 15 to September 15, ten days out of every fourteen. September 16 to May 14, fourteen days out of every eighteen.
- Douglas County resident discount does not apply.
- CABIN 1 is wheelchair accessible.
- When you arrive, you will find that the cabin door has a lockbox. The combination to the lockbox will be noted in your confirmation email or letter. **Please place the key back in the lockbox before you leave.**

*The Park Office starts taking reservations 11 months in advance. To make a Cabin reservation, we need at least 24 hours notice. You are encouraged to call us at 541-957-7001 as soon as possible. Our office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Reservations are taken from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. A \$10.00 non-refundable reservation fee*

*will be charged. Douglas County Park Department reserves the right to charge a key replacement fee if the key is not returned.*

*Cancellation of Cabin reservations must be received at least one week prior to the date of your arrival to receive a refund.*
