DOUGLAS COUNTY PARKS CAMPGROUND RULES

RESERVATIONS:

- You must be 18 years or older to make a reservation, and an adult must be present at the site.
- Individual & Group Sites may be made from eleven months to one week prior to the arrival date.
- Cabins & Yurts may be made from eleven months to 24 hours prior to the arrival date.
- Payment in full is required at the time the reservation is made.
- There is a \$10.00 non-refundable reservation fee.
- There is a \$10.00 administration fee to any modifications after 24 hours of the original reservation date and time.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- Reservations are subject to a \$10.00 cancellation fee for the following:
 - o Individual & Group Camping sites less than two (2) week cancellation notice prior to arrival date.
 - o Cabins, Yurts, & Pavilions less than one (1) week cancellation notice prior to arrival date.
- Cancellations made within 2 to 14 days of the scheduled arrival date are subject to a penalty equal to one (1) night.
- Cancellations made within 1 day of the arrival date are subject to a penalty equal to 100% of the reservation amount and no refund will be given.
- To cancel or make any Changes to your Reservation please call 541-957-7001. For late arrivals or information outside of our normal business hours please call the park directly. This information is available on your reservation confirmation. Changes made within 1 day of scheduled check-in are subject to a penalty equal to one (1) days of reservation.
- No Show check-in's after 2:30 pm **the day after** your scheduled arrival date will have a penalty of your entire reservation(s).
- No refunds will be issued for checking out early once you have arrived.

OUR CAMP RULES ARE:

- For "first come first serve" a physical presence is required to register for a campsite; meaning the person who is to occupy the site must be present, with his or her camping unit, ready to physically occupy the site.
- Fires are allowed in designated areas only.
- Camp stoves may be used in established campsites.
- Firewood must be kept in a neatly stacked pile. Do not leave a fire or a lit portable stove unattended.
- Discharging of firearms is prohibited at any time within the campground.
- BE GOOD NEIGHBORS and keep your camp neat, clean and orderly.
- Deposit trash in the containers provided. Leave your campsite as clean as you found it.
- All pets must be kept on a leash. Please do not permit your animal to run loose, disturb other park users, or the wildlife. Please clean up after your pet. Never leave your pet unattended.

CAMPSITE:

- Must accommodate one camping unit and one operational tow vehicle.
 - o A camping unit is defined as a motorhome, 5th wheel, tent, camper van, or camper.
 - An operational tow vehicle is either a vehicle being towed or the vehicle towing the camping unit. A tow vehicle must occupy a 5th wheel, trailer, truck-camper after sunset.
- A tent is permitted to accompany the primary camping unit in the campsite. Multiple tents are allowed with an extra
 fee of \$5.00. In a non-hook up site it is permitted to have multiple tents, as long as the tents stay within the camp
 site. Sleeping bags are not permitted outside the camping unit.
- Vehicles other than the operational tow vehicles are considered extra vehicles and must pay the extra vehicle fee. If a vehicle is towed in by a RV then it is not considered an extra vehicle.

CHECK-IN TIME is 2:30 pm / CHECK-OUT TIME is 11:00 am. To stay another night payment is required by 11:30 am.

QUIET TIME: 10:00 pm until 7:00 am in the morning. During this time please be considerate of your neighbors. Please keep your pets quiet, do not run generators, play music, or engage in loud behavior.

PARKING: All vehicles, including bicycles and ORV's will travel and park within the designated roads and parking areas and will maintain a speed limit of 10 miles per hour or less. RV's may not be parked out of the established sites.

CAMPER STAY LIMITS: Year-Round: Maximum stay is not to exceed 14 nights within a 30-day period, per campground. 30 nights combined in all Douglas County Parks per calendar year (Jan – Dec). Number of stays is documented by camping unit and vehicle. Oregon State Special Access Pass is limited to 5 free nights per stay, with a maximum stay of 10 nights per calendar year.
