

## EXPLANATION OF CAMPING FEES

**CAMPSITE:** A physical site consisting of parking space for one camping unit and one tow vehicle. A camping unit is defined as any unit that is used for sleeping such as a motor home, 5<sup>th</sup> wheel, tent, camper van or a pickup with canopy or camper. A tow vehicle is either the vehicle being towed or the vehicle towing the camping unit. Any other vehicles are to be considered extra vehicles.

**HOOK -UP SITE:** A campsite that is equipped with water, sewer and electric utilities. Tents are allowed to occupy hook - up sites in all parks except Amacher Park. If a camper occupies a site, the full fee must be paid whether the utilities are used or not.

**NON HOOK - UP SITE:** A campsite with no water, sewer or electric utilities generally designed for tent camping. RV's can occupy tent sites.

**EXTRA TENTS:** A small tent is allowed to accompany the primary camping unit in the campsite. A small tent is defined as a tent designed to be occupied by two or three persons. Any larger tent or multiple tents will be required to pay an extra tent fee, or be placed in another site and pay the appropriate fee.

**EXTRA VEHICLES:** Any vehicle other than the tow vehicle belonging to a campsite for overnight stay. Extra vehicles are allowed to stay in the campsite provided there is space available. Space available means the vehicle must not be parked on turf areas or roadways.

**RESERVATIONS:** We accept reservations up to eleven months to one week advancement. You must be 18 years or older to make reservations and an adult must be present at the site. Payment is required in full at the time the reservation is made. Any changes to your reserved site upon arrival will require checking in with the Camp-host for permission.

**FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE SITES:** **Physical presence is required to register a campsite. By physical presence, we mean the person who is to occupy the site must be present with their camping unit, ready to occupy the site.** Many times a camper will be checking in and wish to pay for another site for another family member or friend who is expected to arrive shortly. This is not acceptable. Registration will not happen until the person actually arrives. Also, we do not allow "holding." It is **not** permitted to come the day before and place a lawn chair in a site to hold it with the intention of returning the next day with a camping rig to occupy it, this applies even if you have paid for the site.
