

HALF MOON BAY CAMPING RULES

There are five group camping sections that may be reserved for a fee of \$60.00 per night for Sections A, B and D, or \$75.00 a night for Sections C and E.

Group Camping Sections:

The group camping area has been divided into five sections – each section accommodates multiple camping units, depending on the size of the unit.

Section A **	Accommodates up to 3 Units
Section B **	Accommodates up to 3 Units
Section C *	Accommodates up to 5 Units
Section D	Accommodates up to 4 Units
Section E *	Accommodates up to 5 Units

* Larger sections

** Sections A & B are prone to flooding in winter months

One person should be designated to be in charge and to pay the balance of the fees upon arrival. Payment at the campground will be either cash or check.

We request that each group camp only in their designated section. If tables are moved during your stay, please return them to their original location.

Individual Sites: There are 13 individual sites available for reservation at \$20.00 per night. A discount of \$2.00 applies to Douglas County Residents.

Payment: A payment of the first night, plus a \$10.00 non-refundable reservation fee *per section and per individual site* is required to make the reservation. The \$10.00 reservation fee is not applicable to your remaining balance. Payment when reserving by telephone must be made by Visa or MasterCard credit or debit cards only. If you are staying more than one night, the remaining balance will be payable by cash or check at the campground upon arrival. Douglas County resident discounts and veterans/active military discounts do not apply to group sites.

Refund: The first night's fee may be refunded for group sites if the reservation is cancelled one month prior to the date of your arrival. For individual sites, notice is required one week prior to the date of your arrival in order to receive a refund of the first night's fee. The \$10 reservation fee is NOT refundable upon cancellation.

The Park Office starts taking reservations eleven months prior to reservation date and not after 2 weeks ahead of time. You are encouraged to call us at 541-957-7001 as soon as possible. Our office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Reservations are taken from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
