A Fir, 16" dia., bears N.8°W., 23 lks., mkd: ¼ S21 BT.

Found - Orig. post, down & rotted, from which a:
16" Fir bears N.8°W., 23 lks., now 30" face covered.
16" Fir bears S.78°E., 10 lks., now 17"x58" high stub, portion of face exposed, scribes 22 visible.
Set - 1½"x36" galv. IP with 3" bronze cap mkd: "Ore. St. Bd. of Forestry ¼ S21 S22 1959 RS359", 33" in ground, from which a:
31" Fir bears S.56°W., 10.9 ft., scribed RS359.
26" Fir bears S.86°E., 27.7 ft., scribed ¼ S22 BT.
