AN OAK 12" DIA. NOW A SHALLOW ROOT-HOLE WITH OAK ROOTS; BEARS N01°E, 82.5 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).  
AN OAK 18" DIA. NOW LARGE DISTINCT ROOT-HOLE; BEARS S24°W, 48.2 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).

TWO 1956 RENEWAL BT'S:  
AN 18" CEDAR NOW A 25 INCH DIA. INCENSE CEDAR WITH A PARTIALLY HEALED DOUBLE BLAZE SHOWING ILLEGIBLE SCRIBING; BEARS N26°12'E, 39.7 FEET DISTANT (RECORD N28°45'E, 39.7').  
A 12" W. OAK NOW A ROTTED AND TIPPED 8 INCH DIA. 2 FOOT TALL OAK STUMP WITH EVIDENCE OF A BLAZE AND A ROTTED FACE (NO SCRIBING); BEARS N87°1/2'E, 27.6 FEET DISTANT (RECORD N85°E, 27.6').

THE 1945 MONUMENT NOTED ABOVE IS DESCRIBED AS BEARING N27°W, 3 1/2 FEET DISTANT IN THE 1956 RENEWAL AND THIS IS AMENDED TO S27°E, 3 1/2 FEET IN THE 1963 CONDITION REPORT.

A N-S FENCELINE IS EAST, 2 FEET DISTANT

A 3 INCH DIAM. INCENSE CEDAR SCRIBED "NE DLC 39" "CSBT" ON A DOUBLE BLAZE; BEARS S53 1/2°E, 192 FEET DISTANT.

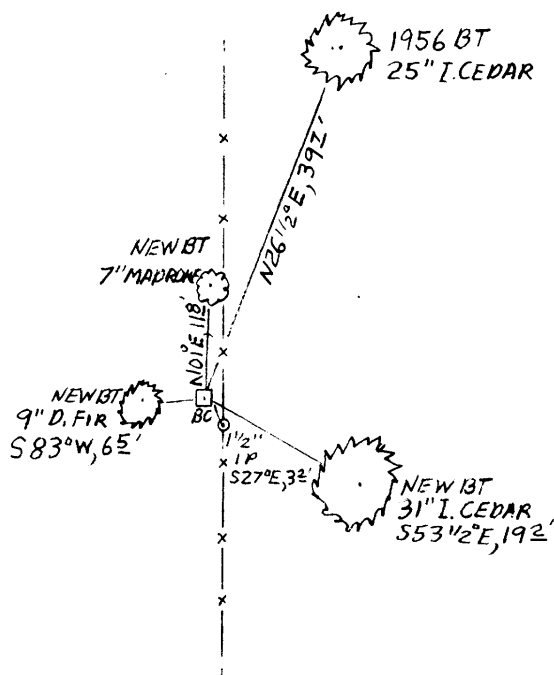
