OTHER THINGS TO KNOW

- Parking space is limited to 1 vehicle in the Cabin area; additional parking is available nearby.
- Douglas County resident discount does not apply
- Camper stay limit – Maximum stay is 14 nights.
- A small tent is allowed to accompany the cabin.
- When you arrive, you will find that the cabin door has a lockbox; the combination is on your confirmation.
- **Please put the key back in the lockbox before you leave.**

The Park Office starts taking reservations 11 months in advance. To make a Cabin reservation, we need at least 24 hours' notice. To make a reservation, please contact the Park office at 541-957-7001, between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. We accept reservations 24 / 7 online at www.co.douglas.or.us/parks. A \$10.00 non-refundable reservation fee will be charged. Douglas County Park Department reserves the right to charge a key replacement fee if the key is not returned.
